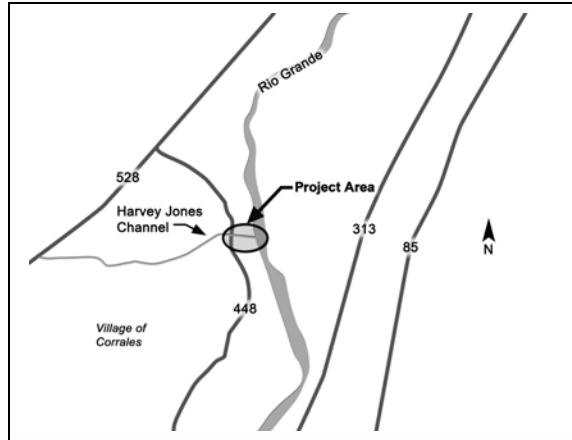

Project Summary: Southern Sandoval County Arroyo Flood Control Authority (SSCAFCA) in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration, New Mexico Department of Transportation, and the Village of Corrales is proposing improvements to the Harvey Jones Channel and the Corrales Road Bridge (NM 448) in the Village of Corrales. The project consists of construction of an additional box culvert to increase capacity under the bridge during storm events, remove the man-made water trap, and the creation of an earthen sediment removal pond to reduce sediment buildup between the bridge and the east end of the Los Montoyas Arroyo.

Please join us to learn more about the project, present concerns, and ask questions. Environmental documentation for the project is being prepared in compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and will include consideration and disclosure of all potential impacts to natural, social, and economic resources within the project area.
