






Upstream culvert crossing

- Bid Highlights
 - Major bid item elements include:
 - Removal of existing drainage structure, channel lining, sidewalk culverts and rundowns, reinforced portland cement concrete
 - Removal of existing 36" CMP
 - Installation of concrete box culverts
 - Installation of rectangular channel lining
 - Channel Lining, 8" thick
 - Relocation of existing waterline

Lisbon Avenue Culvert Replacement Technical Clarifications

- Bid Item 20: Double 24" Sidewalk Drain Single, NM APWA Std Dwg, Complete-In-Place: Remove "Single" from definition
- Bid Item 34: This bid item is for the trapezoidal channel.
- The number and spacing of the casing spacers for 18" and 12" casing pipe shall be per the manufacturer's installation instructions.

- Technical Clarifications
 - The coating for the inside of the 18" casing pipe for the 10-inch waterline shall comply with AWWA requirements.
 - The NMDOT Standard Specifications and Standard Drawings apply to the Double 8' x 5' CBC and to the asphalt paving. The NM APWA Standard Specifications and Standard Drawings, and the CORR Standard Drawings apply to all other work.
 - The earthwork under the rectangular channel shall be as follows: 12" of engineered fill shall be compacted to 95% ASTM D-1557 over 12" subgrade compacted to 95% ASTM D-1557. The 12" of engineered fill is directly below the channel concrete. The subgrade and the engineered fill shall extend to 2' outside the outside edges of the channel.

- Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP)
 - None Required
