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- Bid Highlights

- Bid item elements include:

- Export Material from the site, ~18,400 CY
 - Construct new sanitary treated effluent structure, ~ 20 CY of reinforced concrete
 - Requires by-pass pumping
 - Concrete unit price includes bar grate assembly and manhole ring and cover
 - Lower section of twin 33"x49" CMP arch pipes

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- Overall project layout

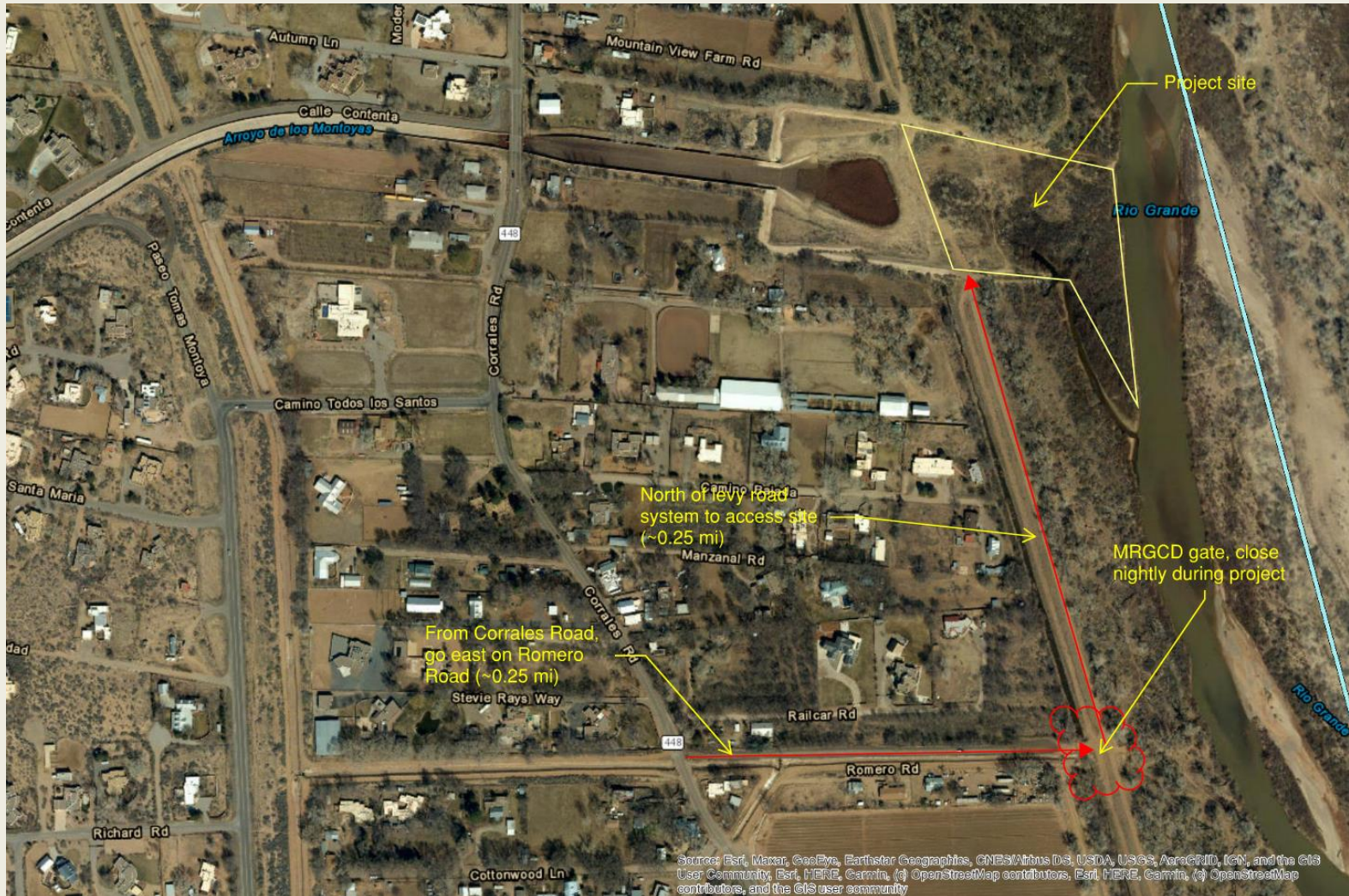


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- External coordination
 - Utility Companies (other than City of Rio Rancho)
 - No known utilities on project site
 - City of Rio Rancho
 - Coordinate by-pass pumping with City Utilities (STS 3030 for guidance on this)
 - Haul permits for material removal
 - Village of Corrales
 - Haul permits
 - Local residents
 - Trail users

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- Site Access



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- Material Disposal
 - All material (soil) will be disposed of at the Sandoval County Landfill
 - Trucks will not have to go through scales but will use different entrance off of Iris Rd.
 - Sandoval County will assist by spreading material
 - Approximate one-way trip to landfill is ~30 min
 - Distance to landfill is ~4.8 miles
