WHEREAS, SSCAFCA adopted a Greenbelt Policy on November 15, 1990 when it approved its Comprehensive Preliminary Needs Assessment and General Flood Control Program for Southern Sandoval County; and

WHEREAS, SSCAFCA further defined its policy on a Greenbelt Concept in its board meeting of March 17, 1992; and

WHEREAS, SSCAFCA wishes to further define this policy in a formal resolution;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by SSCAFCA that:

- 1. Goal Number 2 as set forth in its Comprehensive Preliminary Needs Assessment and General Flood Control Program for Southern Sandoval County shall continue to be an important goal and strategy of SSCAFCA.
- 2. Multi use park-like facilities, which includes parks, recreation facilities, golf courses, tennis courts, lakes, biking trails, etc. will be developed with cooperating entities, where possible, to assist in preventative flood control.
