ICIP

- All Public Agencies in NM required to develop/update their ICIP annually.
- Managed by the Department of Finance & Administration (DFA).
- DFA requires public posting & opportunity for public comment
- Listing on the ICIP an eligibility requirement for the use of State Funds.
- Special districts are required to submit ICIP listing by July 15, 2023
 - This meeting opens the public comment period on SSCAFCA's ICIP list

ICIP Project List - Additions

- Trevino Channel Stabilization (2025-004)
 - Existing degraded channel
 - Needs reconstruction and access
- Sportsplex Dam Outfall rehabilitation (2026-003)
 - Arroyo immediately downstream of Sportsplex Dam is severely degraded
 - Need grade control and bank protection
- Land Acquisition for LEE, OOL, & water resource conservation (2026-004)
 - Many properties in jurisdiction have been impacted by arroyos and LEE.
 - Funding for the acquisition of properties impaired by arroyos and/or LEE
- Mariposa Pond 5 to Patchogue Road (2026-005)
 - Degraded arroyo reach and roadway crossing with potential safety issues
- Montoyas Arroyo Reach Stabilization, Broadmoor to Acadia Ct. (2028-003)
 - Provide bank and grade stabilization for this arroyo segment
- Aloe Pond Design and Construction (2029-001)
 - A facility on the Lomitas Negras system to attenuate hydrograph for downstream constraints
- Montoyas Arroyo Reach Stabilization, Northern to Unser (2029-003)
 - Provide bank and grade stabilization for this arroyo segment
- Lisbon Channel, Phase V (Algodones Ct. to Tarpon Rd.)
 - Channel improvements in degrading urban channel
